

## PERSONAL PROTECTION POLICY Effective June 28th, 2021

## Purpose:

Based on the Governor's announcement lifting all COVID-19 Restrictions in New York, Swedish Institute is replacing its COVID-19 Preparedness and Response Plan with a Personal Protection Policy as of June 28th, 2021. The policy is designed to outline guidelines and expectations for employees, students, and visitors who are present on campus at any time.

## Policy:

- 1. While on campus, employees, students and visitors are required to wear face masks at all times, regardless of their COVID-19 vaccination status. (Those who are not vaccinated against COVID-19 are strongly advised to do so for their own protection.)
- 2. Health screening for employees, students and visitors upon arrival at the campus will continue until further notice.
- 3. Students must continue to wear their uniform to school or change into their uniform upon arrival.
- 4. Employees and students who are ill are advised to stay at home and inform their immediate supervisor or instructor.
- Employees and students are accountable for their own personal health care precautions to prevent any unnecessary infection or contamination of others by staying home and if necessary, selfquarantine.
- 6. Heightened personal hygiene, including proper and frequent hand-washing and use of sanitizing products, continues to be highly recommended.
- 7. Frequent janitorial services and cleaning/sanitizing will continue based on the current CDC quidelines.
